## The Biblical yet Missing Key to God's Blessing on Your Life and Massive Revival

Did you know that there's something you can do that will bring God's blessing on your life, help bring revival around the world, and even hasten the day of Jesus' return? When you do this, you'll also deeply bless God's heart.

So what is it? **It's praying for Israel to turn to their Messiah and be saved.**

Why's that so important to God? Because He has an incredible plan of bringing revival to the world, and Israel's salvation is the missing puzzle piece.

### Jesus' Amazing Statement about Israel

As Jesus, Yeshua, was entering Jerusalem 2,000 years ago, He began to weep. **He came to seek and save "the lost sheep of the house of Israel"** (Matthew 15:24).

But knowing that many would reject Him, He said in tears, "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem.... How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing!" (Matthew 23:37).

But then He made an amazing statement to the people of Israel that affects the whole world. He said that they wouldn't see Him again until they say to Him, "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord" (see Matthew 23:37-39).

Since Jesus is returning to Jerusalem, this means that He actually won't return to earth until the Jewish people in Israel welcome Him! **So the salvation of Israel is an indispensable key for the coming of our Messiah and King and the restoration of all things!**

### The Revival in Israel is Beginning

So how will these people be saved? First, God promised to gather the dry bones of Israel back to their ancient homeland and that the nation of Israel would be reborn (eg. Ezekiel 37, Isaiah 66) - and here we are!

But that's only the first part of the restoration, because God also said that His people would return to Israel still in their sin, **but once they'd return, He would breathe His Spirit upon them so that they would live (Ezekiel 36-37).**

The Lord has also begun doing that! **More so than any time in the last 2,000 years, Israelis are beginning to turn to their Messiah!** Here at Tree of Life Ministries in Israel, we see this happening before our eyes.

By God's grace, millions of Israelis have watched our evangelistic and pro-life videos, thousands have heard the Gospel on the streets, and Israelis from every background have come to faith and chosen life.

### Facing Significant Strongholds

But we're still facing some major obstacles. The Holocaust, the Crusades, and other calamities have left many Israelis feeling either that God doesn't exist, or that He just doesn't care.

Many also believe the old lie that Jesus Himself was the cause of these horrible events. Add onto this that the religious authorities in Israel systematically teach against any possibility of Jesus being the Messiah, and the result is a people most of whose eyes are still veiled to their Messiah.

### Your Role in God's Grand Finale

But that's where you come into the story, fulfilling a role only you can. In Romans 11, **God calls you, followers of Jesus all around the world, to provoke the Jewish people to jealousy and intercede for them**, so that "through the mercy shown you they also may obtain mercy" (v. 31), finding salvation in Jesus.

There's also an astonishing promise in Romans 11 that once Israel turns to their Messiah, it will bring "greater riches" and "life from the dead" to the rest of the world (verses 11-15) - a revival greater than anything we've ever seen!

When just a small group of Jewish people received their Messiah 2,000 years ago, they spread the Good News everywhere, and look how many were saved - including you!

But imagine how many multitudes will be swept into the Kingdom when "all Israel will be saved" (Romans 11:26), and will fulfill their original calling to bring God's blessing to the world (Genesis 12:3).

And imagine you and us, Gentile and Jewish followers of Jesus, **working together as One New Man in the final, glorious harvest! What a grand finale God has planned for us!**





## Watchmen on the Walls of Jerusalem

So what's the next step? **In Isaiah 62, God calls all of us to be watchmen on the walls of Jerusalem - to never keep silent, and give Him no rest until Israel's salvation shines as a burning torch.**

Listen to God's heart for His covenant people, as the Apostle Paul expressed it in Romans 10:1, **"Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved."**

Is that your heart's desire? Is that your prayer? If so, then this 21 day prayer guide was made for you!

Each day focuses on a key prayer topic for Israel, and contains strategic prayer points that show what the main strongholds and challenges on the ground are in Israel.

And each day also includes powerful promises and proclamations from Scripture related to each topic that will inspire your faith, help you see God's plans and purposes, and give you a glimpse into His heart for His people, Israel.

# Deep Transformation of Hearts in Israel

Day 1

## Prayer Points

- That Jewish people will recognize God's love for them and their deep need for their Messiah, who can cleanse them and give them a new heart
- That Israelis will realize that it wasn't merely their own strength or ingenuity that brought about the miracle of Israel, but rather God's great faithfulness, power, and grace toward them
- That God will soften His people's hearts, remove all obstacles to the Good News, and cause many to trust in Jesus the Messiah
- That, since God has regathered the dry bones of Israel and placed flesh upon them, He will now send His Spirit and breathe new life into them, transforming every facet of their lives and of society

## Key Scriptures

**Ezekiel 36:24-28** "For I will take you from among the nations, gather you out of all countries, and bring you into your own land. Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them. Then you shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; you shall be My people, and I will be your God."

*Jesus' original name in Hebrew is "Yeshua," which means "salvation." God said that even His name is a promise of the salvation of Israel:*

**Matthew 1:21** "And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

**Ezekiel 37:1-14** The hand of the Lord came upon me and brought me out in the Spirit of the Lord, and set me down in the midst of the valley; and it was full of bones. Then He caused me to pass by them all around, and behold, there were very many in the open valley; and indeed they were very dry.

And He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?"

So I answered, "O Lord God, You know."

Again He said to me, "Prophesy to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the Lord! Thus says the Lord God to these bones: "Surely I will cause breath to enter into you, and you shall live. I will put sinews on you and bring flesh upon you, cover you with skin and put breath in you; and you shall live. Then you shall know that I am the Lord." ' "

So I prophesied as I was commanded; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone. Indeed, as I looked, the sinews and the flesh came upon them, and the skin covered them over; but there was no breath in them.

Also He said to me, "Prophesy to the breath, prophesy, son of man, and say to the breath, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they may live."

" So I prophesied as He commanded me, and breath came into them, and they lived, and stood upon their feet, an exceedingly great army.


Then He said to me, "Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. They indeed say, 'Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off!' Therefore prophesy and say to them, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Behold, O My people, I will open your graves and cause you to come up from your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel. Then you shall know that I am the Lord, when I have opened your graves, O My people, and brought you up from your graves. I will put My Spirit in you, and you shall live, and I will place you in your own land. Then you shall know that I, the Lord, have spoken it and performed it," says the Lord."

**Zephaniah 3:12-13** "I will leave in your midst a humble and lowly people, and they shall take refuge in the name of the Lord. The remnant of Israel shall do no unrighteousness and speak no lies, nor shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth; for they shall feed and lie down, and no one shall make them afraid."

**Zechariah 13:1-2a** "In that day a fountain shall be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for uncleanness. It shall be in that day," says the Lord of hosts, "that I will cut off the names of the idols from the land, and they shall no longer be remembered."

## Seeing Yeshua as a Brother, not an Enemy

Day 2

### Prayer Points

- That God will pull down the stubborn stronghold that causes Israelis to believe that Yeshua is the cause of the Crusades, inquisitions, pogroms, and Holocaust
- That true believers - both Gentile and Jewish - will faithfully represent Yeshua by showing genuine love to Jewish non-believers, and that doors will be opened for sharing the Gospel
- That God will fill believers with wisdom, sensitivity, and patience to share the Good News with Jewish people and answer objections with grace, clearly presenting their own Messiah to them
- That God will stir Israelis' hearts to be willing to seek and read the truth about Yeshua in the New Testament (currently considered a forbidden book for many of them), and to understand that He is not the source of hatred but of love
- That Jewish people will see that Yeshua is not their enemy, but rather the One who loves them deeply and gave Himself for them, and that they'll surrender their lives to Him

### Key Scriptures

*Isaiah 53 is a double prophecy. It foretells the Messiah's sacrificial death. But it's also written from the perspective of Jewish people looking back at the One whom they rejected and realizing that He was actually the Messiah who suffered and died for their sins. And more and more Israelis are beginning to receive that revelation now:*

**Isaiah 53:3-6** He was despised and forsaken of men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; and like one from whom men hide their face He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. Surely our griefs He Himself bore, and our sorrows He carried; yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed. We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

**Zechariah 12:10** "And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn."

**Deuteronomy 18:18-19** "I will raise up for them a Prophet like you from among their brethren, and will put My words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him. And it shall be that whoever will not hear My words, which He speaks in My name, I will require it of him."

**Isaiah 61:1-3** "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn, to console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified."


**Isaiah 59:20-21** "The Redeemer will come to Zion, and to those who turn from transgression in Jacob," says the Lord.

"As for Me," says the Lord, "this is My covenant with them: My Spirit who is upon you, and My words which I have put in your mouth, shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your descendants, nor from the mouth of your descendants' descendants," says the Lord, "from this time and forevermore."

**Isaiah 54:8** "With a little wrath I hid My face from you for a moment; but with everlasting kindness I will have mercy on you," says the Lord, your Redeemer."

**Romans 11:23-24** And they also, if they do not continue in unbelief, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again. For if you were cut out of the olive tree which is wild by nature, and were grafted contrary to nature into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these, who are natural branches, be grafted into their own olive tree?

**John 1:29b** "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"



## Realizing Yeshua is the Jewish Messiah, not the Founder of a Foreign Religion

Day 3

### Prayer Points

- That Israelis won't automatically reject Yeshua because they think that He established a new religion separate from the Hebrew Scriptures (Old Testament), but instead will see that He was the fulfillment of all that the Hebrew prophets spoke of
- That Israelis will be willing to read the New Testament and see that it's not a dangerous and anti-Semitic book that contradicts the Hebrew Scriptures, but instead is the continuation of the beautiful history of God's redemption of mankind through the Messiah
- That more and more Jewish people will see that Yeshua came as a Jewish man to His own people, lived according to Hebrew Scriptures, celebrated the Biblical Feasts of the Lord, and fulfilled the Messianic prophecies
- That God will raise up more believers - Jewish and Gentile - to effectively share the Gospel with Jewish people in a way that connects with their own life and culture, and that they will embrace Yeshua as their own Messiah
- That just as Joseph revealed himself to his brothers and they recognized that he wasn't a foreigner and were finally reconciled to him, Yeshua will reveal Himself to His people and they will see Him as their brother and Savior

### Key Scriptures

**Genesis 45:1-2, 4, 7** Then Joseph could not restrain himself before all those who stood by him, and he cried out, "Make everyone go out from me!" So no one stood with him while Joseph made himself known to his brothers. And he wept aloud, and the Egyptians and the house of Pharaoh heard it....

And Joseph said to his brothers, "Please come near to me." So they came near....Then he said: "I am Joseph your brother, whom you sold into Egypt. And God sent me before you to preserve a posterity for you in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance."

**2 Corinthians 3:14b-17** For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the veil is taken away in Christ. But even to this day, when Moses is read, a veil lies on their heart. Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

**Luke 24:44-47** Then He said to them, "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me." And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures.

Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem."

**Matthew 5:17-18** "Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled."

**Acts 28:23** So when they had appointed [Paul] a day, many came to him at his lodging, to whom he explained and solemnly testified of the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets, from morning till evening.

**Acts 6:8-10** And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and signs among the people. Then there arose some from what is called the Synagogue of the Freedmen...disputing with Stephen. And they were not able to resist the wisdom and the Spirit by which he spoke.

**John 1:14, 16-17** And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen His glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.... For from His fullness we have all received, grace upon grace. For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

**Ezekiel 39:29** "And I will not hide My face from them anymore; for I shall have poured out My Spirit on the house of Israel," says the Lord God.



# Flourishing of Congregations and the Body of Messiah in Israel

Day 4

## Prayer Points

- That all Israeli believers will be grounded in God's Word, filled with His Spirit, walking in holiness, not conforming to the patterns of this world, not led astray by false teachings, and fulfilling their destiny in Messiah
- That pastors and ministry leaders will be filled with God's Spirit, wisdom, direction, and strength; and will set an example of Yeshua to the rest of the Body
- For strong marriages and families growing together in the Lord, true intergenerational unity, and for the young generation to be pure, protected from the evil one, and bearing much fruit
- For supernatural humility, unity, and love; for stronger relationships and partnership together for the sake of the Gospel
- That all members of the Body of Messiah will make the most of the opportunities God gives to be a witness of Jesus, resulting in great increase and many salvations

## Key Scriptures

**Matthew 16:18b** "On this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it."

**Acts 2:42-43a, 46-47** They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Everyone kept feeling a sense of awe.... Day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they were taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart, praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved.

**Ephesians 4:11-16** And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head - Christ - from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

**1 Peter 5:1-5** The elders who are among you I exhort, I who am a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that will be revealed: Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly; nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock; and when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away. Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

**Malachi 4:5-6** "Behold, I am going to send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and terrible day of the Lord. He will turn the hearts of the fathers back to their children and the hearts of the children to their fathers, so that I will not come and strike the land with complete destruction."

**Isaiah 54:13** All your children shall be taught by the Lord, and great shall be the peace of your children.

**John 13:34-35** "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

**John 17:15** "I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one."

**John 17:21-23** "That they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me. And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one: I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me."





## Salvation for Orthodox Jews

Day 5

### Prayer Points

- That God would stir their hearts to actually read the Word of God for themselves, and that they'd have the courage to break free from tradition and religious leaders when they contradict the Scriptures
- That they'd see that their righteous works and ethnicity can't save them, but only God's grace given as we trust in the Messiah, Yeshua, and receive His perfect sacrifice for us
- That religious leaders themselves would find the truth and surrender their lives to Yeshua, like Saul of Tarsus
- That God would fill followers of Yeshua with His love and wisdom to overcome all theological objections and the deeply ingrained hatred for Yeshua
- That they would not be satisfied with mere religion, but would thirst for a real relationship with the living God and find it through His Son

### Key Scriptures

**Romans 11:28-31** Concerning the Gospel [Jewish non-believers] are enemies for your sake, but concerning the election they are beloved for the sake of the fathers. For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable. For as you were once disobedient to God, yet have now obtained mercy through their disobedience, even so these also have now been disobedient, that through the mercy shown you they also may obtain mercy.

**Isaiah 29:13-14** Therefore the Lord said: "In as much as these people draw near with their mouths and honor Me with their lips, but have removed their hearts far from Me, and their fear toward Me is taught by the commandment of men, therefore, behold, I will again do a

marvelous work among this people, a marvelous work and a wonder; for the wisdom of their wise men shall perish, and the understanding of their prudent men shall be hidden."

**Acts 9:4-6a** Then [Saul] fell to the ground, and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?" And he said, "Who are You, Lord?" Then the Lord said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. It is hard for you to kick against the goads." So he, trembling and astonished, said, "Lord, what do You want me to do?"

**Isaiah 66:2** "For all these things My hand has made, and thus they came into being," declares the Lord. "But to this one I will look: to him who is poor and contrite in spirit, and who trembles at My word."

**Isaiah 44:2-3** Thus says the Lord who made you and formed you from the womb, who will help you: "Fear not, O Jacob My servant; and you, Jeshurun, whom I have chosen. For I will pour water on him who is thirsty, and floods on the dry ground; I will pour My Spirit on your descendants, and My blessing on your offspring"

**Romans 9:31-10:2** But Israel, pursuing the law of righteousness, has not attained to the law of righteousness. Why? Because they did not seek it by faith, but as it were, by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumbling stone. As it is written:

"Behold, I lay in Zion a stumbling stone and rock of offense, and whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."

Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved. For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge.

**Acts 17:2-3** As was his custom, Paul went into the synagogue, and on three Sabbath days he reasoned with them from the Scriptures, explaining and proving that the Messiah had to suffer and rise from the dead. "This Jesus I am proclaiming to you is the Messiah," he said.

**Philippians 3:7-11** [After Paul listed his religious achievements in Judaism]: But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for the sake of Christ. More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing excellence of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith; that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, if, by any means, I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.





## Repentance and Redemption for Secular Jews

Day 6

### Prayer Points

- That they'll know that God hasn't forsaken them in spite of the Holocaust and other tragedies, but that He has been faithful to His covenant, He's preserved a remnant, and brought them back to their land so that they will meet with Him
- That they'll sense an emptiness from all the pleasures and philosophies of this world, hunger for truth, and find fulfillment in the only One who is Truth, Yeshua
- That Israeli believers will be able to show an example of abundant life in God as opposed to the dryness of Orthodox Judaism, so that secular Israelis will see the beauty and love of God as expressed in Yeshua
- That there will be a deep and widespread repentance for the rampant practices of abortion, homosexuality, drugs, etc., and that they'll choose the path of life and righteousness in Jesus
- That they won't follow the worldly example of the rest of the nations (just like in Biblical times), but will embrace God's special calling to be a blessing to the nations through Yeshua

### Key Scriptures

**Isaiah 49:14-16** But Zion said, "The Lord has forsaken me, and my Lord has forgotten me."

"Can a woman forget her nursing child, and not have compassion on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, yet I will not forget you. See, I have inscribed you on the palms of My hands; your walls are continually before Me."

**1 Corinthians 6:9-11** Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.

**Isaiah 62:12** [Of the Jewish people and Jerusalem]: And they shall call them The Holy People, the Redeemed of the Lord; and you shall be called Sought Out, a City Not Forsaken.

**Isaiah 4:2-3** In that day the Branch of the Lord shall be beautiful and glorious; and the fruit of the earth shall be excellent and appealing for those of Israel who have escaped. And it shall come to pass that he who is left in Zion and remains in Jerusalem will be called holy - everyone who is recorded among the living in Jerusalem.

**Isaiah 26:1a, 8-9** In that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah.... "Yes, Lord, walking in the way of Your laws, we wait for You; Your name and renown are the desire of our hearts. My soul yearns for You in the night; in the morning my spirit longs for You. When Your judgments come upon the earth, the people of the world learn righteousness."

**Romans 5:8** But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

**Luke 15:17-19** "But when [the prodigal son] came to himself, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger! I will arise and go to my father, and will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you, and I am no longer worthy to be called your son. Make me like one of your hired servants."'

**Ezekiel 20:32-35** "What you have in your mind shall never be, when you say, 'We will be like the Gentiles, like the families in other countries, serving wood and stone.' As I live," says the Lord God, "surely with a mighty hand, with an outstretched arm, and with fury poured out, I will rule over you. I will bring you out from the peoples and gather you out of the countries where you are scattered.... And I will bring you into the wilderness of the peoples, and there I will plead My case with you face to face."

**Isaiah 44:21b-23** "O Israel, you will not be forgotten by Me! I have blotted out, like a thick cloud, your transgressions, and like a cloud, your sins. Return to Me, for I have redeemed you.

"Sing, O heavens, for the Lord has done it! Shout, you lower parts of the earth; break forth into singing, you mountains, O forest, and every tree in it! For the Lord has redeemed Jacob, and glorified Himself in Israel.



## Revelation of Jesus for Israeli New Agers

Day 7

### Prayer Points

- That the hundreds of thousands of Israelis involved in New Age practices and festivals, meditation, and Kabbalah (Jewish mysticism) will grasp that they're actually engaging in idolatry and opening themselves to evil spirits
- That God will shatter the illusion that they themselves are gods or that everything is god, and that they'll have a healthy fear of the true God
- That the Lord will send believers full of His love, truth, and power to effectively share the Word of God with them in a way they'll understand
- That they won't see Jesus as just "another philosophy," but will recognize their own sin and need for Him, and see that He alone is the Way, the Truth, and the Life
- That they will be hungry for truth, desire to read God's Word, and have personal encounters with Jesus, seeing His love and power

### Key Scriptures

**Acts 26:18** "...to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me."

**Ezekiel 28:2b** Thus says the Lord God: "Because your heart is lifted up, and you say, 'I am a god, I sit in the seat of gods, in the midst of the seas,' yet you are a man, and not a god, though you set your heart as the heart of a god"

**1 Corinthians 1:29-31** So that no man may boast before God. But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption, so that, just as it is written, "Let him who boasts, boast in the Lord."

**Isaiah 26:12-13** Lord, You will establish peace for us, for even all we have accomplished, You have done in us. Lord, our God, masters besides You have ruled us; but through You alone we make Your name known.

**Isaiah 29:22-24** Therefore thus says the Lord, who redeemed Abraham, concerning the house of Jacob: "Jacob shall not now be ashamed, nor shall his face now grow pale; but when he sees his children, the work of My hands, in his midst, they will hallow My name, and hallow the Holy One of Jacob, and fear the God of Israel. These also who erred in spirit will come to understanding, and those who complained will learn doctrine."

**Isaiah 31:6-7** Return to Him against whom you have been profoundly obstinate, you sons of Israel. For on that day every person will reject his silver idols and his gold idols, which your hands have made for you as a sin.

**Isaiah 30:22** You will also defile the covering of your images of silver, and the ornament of your molded images of gold. You will throw them away as an unclean thing; you will say to them, "Get away!"

**Hosea 14:4-5, 8** "I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely, for My anger has turned away from him. I will be like the dew to Israel; he shall blossom like the lily; he shall take root like the trees of Lebanon.... O Ephraim, what have I to do with idols? It is I who answer and look after you. I am like an evergreen cypress; from Me comes your fruit."

**Jeremiah 2:11, 13** "Has a nation changed its gods, which are not gods? But My people have changed their Glory for what does not profit.... For My people have committed two evils: They have forsaken Me, the fountain of living waters, and hewn themselves cisterns-broken cisterns that can hold no water."

**Joel 2:27-29** "Then you shall know that I am in the midst of Israel: I am the Lord your God and there is no other. My people shall never be put to shame. And it shall come to pass afterward that I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions. And also on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days."

**Micah 4:5** For all people walk each in the name of his god, but we will walk in the name of the Lord our God forever and ever.



## Spiritual Awakening for Arab Israelis

Day 8

### Prayer Points

- That the Prince of Peace will bring healing and wholeness to all roots of rejection and bitterness originating from the “family feud” in Genesis, and that Arab Israelis will experience the love and peace of God in Jesus
- That the Muslim Arabs will be delivered from the snare of Islam, and have a revelation of Jesus as the Son of God and risen Savior
- That the nominal Christian Arabs will experience a true awakening, realizing that a mere cultural connection to Jesus or intellectual assent that He is Messiah won’t save them – that they’ll truly surrender their lives to Him
- That God will fill the Arabs who are true believers with His Spirit, love, and power, and they’ll arise to fulfill their calling to provoke Jewish people to jealousy and spread the Gospel to both Jews and Arabs

### Key Scriptures

**Matthew 11:28-30** “Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”

**Genesis 16:11, 13** And the Angel of the Lord said to [Hagar]: “Behold, you are with child, and you shall bear a son. You shall call his name Ishmael, because the Lord has heard your affliction....

“Then she called the name of the Lord who spoke to her, You-Are-the-God-Who-Sees; for she said, “Have I also here seen Him who sees me?”

**Genesis 17:20** “And as for Ishmael, I have heard you. Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly. He shall beget twelve princes, and I will make him a great nation.”

**Genesis 21:15-20a** And the water in the skin was used up, and [Hagar] placed [Ishmael] under one of the shrubs. Then she went and sat down across from him at a distance of about a bowshot; for she said to herself, “Let me not see the death of the boy.” So she sat opposite him, and lifted her voice and wept. And God heard the voice of the lad. Then the angel of God called to Hagar out of heaven, and said to her, “What ails you, Hagar? Fear not, for God has heard the voice of the lad where he is. Arise, lift up the lad and hold him with your hand, for I will make him a great nation.” Then God opened her eyes, and she saw a well of water. And she went and filled the skin with water, and gave the lad a drink. So God was with the lad

**Matthew 16:15-16** [Jesus] said to them, “But who do you say that I am?” Simon Peter answered and said, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.”

**John 14:6** Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.”

**Revelation 3:15, 20-21** [Directed at lukewarm/nominal believers]: “I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot.... As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent. Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me. To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.

**Ephesians 2:11-13** Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh...that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

**Romans 10:11-12** For the Scripture says, “Whoever believes in Him will not be put to shame.” For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, abounding in riches for all who call on Him

**2 Corinthians 5:16a, 17-20** Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh.... Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ’s behalf, be reconciled to God.





## Online Evangelism in Israel

Day 9

### Prayer Points

- That the millions of seeds of the Good News sown through evangelistic videos in the past few years will bear more and more fruit, leading to many salvations
- That God will anoint evangelistic ministries with wisdom to produce more powerful Gospel videos that will help remove obstacles to faith in Yeshua and present who He really is to His people
- That the Lord will give grace and understanding to respond and follow up with the tens of thousands of seekers on social media, and to help all those who do come to faith to connect with local congregations and grow in their faith
- That God will stir even more Israelis to search for Yeshua online (recently Yeshua became the most searched for religious term in Israel - even more than God) and find the truth
- That even more Israelis will order the New Testament (which isn't available in regular bookstores, but only through evangelistic ministry websites) - that they'll read it and encounter their Messiah
- That God will give favor and breakthroughs so that evangelistic videos won't be censored by social media giants, but instead, the Gospel will spread without hindrance and have a deep impact on many

### Key Scriptures

**Luke 8:11, 15** "Now this is the parable: the seed is the word of God.... But the seed in the good soil, these are the ones who have heard the word with a good and virtuous heart, and hold it firmly, and produce fruit with perseverance."

**Isaiah 55:10-11** "For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and do not return there, but water the earth, and make it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it."

**Jeremiah 29:11-14b** [Spoken to Israel]: "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you," says the Lord, "thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart. I will be found by you," says the Lord.

**Acts 18:28** For he powerfully refuted his Jewish opponents in public debate, proving from the Scriptures that Jesus is the Messiah.

**Ephesians 6:18-20** Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints - and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the Gospel, for which I am an ambassador...that in it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

**John 7:37-38** On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water."

**Matthew 13:45** "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking beautiful pearls, who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had and bought it."

**2 Thessalonians 3:1-3** Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may run swiftly and be glorified, just as it is with you, and that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men; for not all have faith. But the Lord is faithful, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one.

**Isaiah 55:6-7** Seek the Lord while He may be found, call upon Him while He is near. Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the Lord, and He will have mercy on him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon.



## Gospel Spreading on the Streets of Israel

Day 10

### Prayer Points

- That God will use all the different outreaches to bring a greater openness to the Gospel and even more Israelis into a relationship with Him (we've seen a significant increase of Israelis receiving Yeshua on the streets recently!)
- That God will send out more laborers into the harvest: filled with His compassion, sensitivity, and boldness; overcoming all fears and societal pressures; and reaching out with the Gospel in all spheres of life
- That the Lord will grant greater unity and anointing to all Israeli followers of Yeshua, so that as we go out on the streets as Jewish and Arab believers – one new man in Messiah – there will be a living testimony of Yeshua's power to transform lives
- That God will break through with signs, wonders, and healings on the streets in order to confirm the word of the Gospel, and that many multitudes will be swept into the Kingdom, like in the Book of Acts

### Key Scriptures

**Isaiah 40:9** Get yourself up on a high mountain, you who bring good news to Zion! Lift up your voice with strength, you who bring good news to Jerusalem! Lift it up! Do not fear! Say to the cities of Judah: "Behold your God!"

**Romans 1:16** For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes – to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile.

**Acts 4:13** Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

**Isaiah 45:25** "In the Lord all the descendants of Israel shall be justified, and shall glory."

**Exodus 4:12b** "Go, and I will be with your mouth and teach you what you shall say."

**Luke 10:1-2** After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go. Then He said to them, "The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."

**2 Corinthians 2:14** But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of the knowledge of Him in every place.

**Acts 5:20** "Go, stand in the temple and speak to the people all the words of this life."

**Acts 17:17** Therefore he reasoned [concerning the Gospel] in the synagogue with the Jews and with the Gentile worshipers, and in the marketplace daily with those who happened to be there.

**Psalms 96:2** Sing to the Lord, bless His name; proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day.

**Colossians 4:2-6** Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving. At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ, on account of which I am in prison – that I may make it clear, which is how I ought to speak.

Walk in wisdom toward outsiders, making the best use of the time. Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person.

**Micah 7:14-15** Shepherd Your people with Your staff, the flock of Your heritage, who dwell alone in a woodland, in the midst of Carmel; let them feed in Bashan and Gilead, as in days of old.

"As in the days when you came out of the land of Egypt, I will show them wonders."

**Mark 16:20** And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. Amen.



## Solid Discipleship for New Israeli Believers

Day 11

### Prayer Points

- That the new believers will recognize their need for discipleship, have the courage to overcome pressure from family and society, and will join congregations and become true disciples
- That as a wave of new believers is beginning to come in, God will grant wisdom to the local congregations and ministries to create discipleship programs and groups to help the new believers grow and flourish
- That the new believers will have solid foundations in the Word of God, be filled with His Spirit, and truly learn to submit every area of their lives to Yeshua and to be transformed into His image
- That the thousands of believers who are currently disconnected from fellowship will desire to connect with the Body of Messiah, become solid disciples, and be a part of building God's Kingdom
- That every single believer will be equipped to not only share the Gospel, but also to make new disciples who make disciples, launching a movement of multiplication

### Key Scriptures

**Matthew 28:18-20** Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

**John 8:31-32** So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, "If you abide in My word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

**Romans 12:1-2** Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God - this is your true and proper worship. Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is - His good, pleasing and perfect will.

**Hebrews 10:23-25** Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful. And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

**Mark 10:29-30** So Jesus answered and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My sake and the gospel's, who shall not receive a hundred fold now in this time - houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions - and in the age to come, eternal life."

**1 Peter 2:2-3** As newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby, if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is gracious.

**Romans 6:4** Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

**1 Peter 2:9** But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light

**Luke 9:23-24** Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it."

**Deuteronomy 6:6-7** "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up."





## God's Protection so Israel can Fulfill their Destiny

Day 12

### Prayer Points

- That God will miraculously protect His covenant people Israel from attacks from enemy nations and terrorist groups, and that many in Israel and the nations will realize that He is the true, sovereign God as a result
- That God will grant wisdom and grace to Israeli government and military leaders, so they can make sound decisions leading to greater security, while treating their neighbors with dignity
- That God will pull down strongholds of Islam and bring salvation to many in the Middle East, including to those who currently are seeking to harm Israel
- That the Lord will give great favor to the believers in the Israeli military, that they'll be an excellent witness for Yeshua, having wisdom, boldness, and tact to share the Gospel as He opens doors
- That God will work through whatever trials and crises He does allow to cause Israel to seek a refuge greater than themselves, the government, and the military - that they will seek God Himself, and find Him through Yeshua

### Key Scriptures

**Joel 3:16-17a** The Lord also will roar from Zion, and utter His voice from Jerusalem; the heavens and earth will shake; but the Lord will be a shelter for His people, and the strength of the children of Israel.

"So you shall know that I am the Lord your God, dwelling in Zion My holy mountain. Then Jerusalem shall be holy"

**Psalms 121:1-2, 4** I will lift up my eyes to the hills - from whence comes my help? My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth.... Behold, He who keeps Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.

**Isaiah 41:8-11a, 16b** "But you, Israel, are My servant, Jacob whom I have chosen, the descendants of Abraham My friend. You whom I have taken from the ends of the earth...and have not cast you away; fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.

"Behold, all those who were incensed against you shall be ashamed and disgraced.... You shall rejoice in the Lord, and glory in the Holy One of Israel."

**Ezekiel 39:7** [After promising to supernaturally deliver Israel from attacks]: "So I will make My holy name known in the midst of My people Israel, and I will not let them profane My holy name anymore. Then the nations shall know that I am the Lord, the Holy One in Israel."

**Isaiah 10:20-21** And it shall come to pass in that day that the remnant of Israel, and such as have escaped of the house of Jacob, will never again depend on him who defeated them, but will depend on the Lord, the Holy One of Israel, in truth. The remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, to the Mighty God.

**Isaiah 25:9** And it will be said in that day: "Behold, this is our God; we have waited for Him, and He will save us. This is the Lord; we have waited for Him; we will be glad and rejoice in His salvation."

**Psalms 83:4-5, 16a, 18** They have said, "Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation, that the name of Israel may be remembered no more."

For they have consulted together with one consent; they form a confederacy against You....

Fill their faces with shame, that they may seek Your name, O Lord.... That they may know that You, whose name alone is the Lord, are the Most High over all the earth.

**Isaiah 54:14-15** In righteousness you shall be established; you shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear; and from terror, for it shall not come near you. Indeed they shall surely assemble, but not because of Me. Whoever assembles against you shall fall for your sake.

**Isaiah 43:1-2, 4a** But now, thus says the Lord, who created you, O Jacob, and He who formed you, O Israel:

"Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; you are Mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, nor shall the flame scorch you.... Since you were precious in My sight, you have been honored, and I have loved you"

**Jeremiah 30:7b, 9** "And it is the time of Jacob's trouble, but he shall be saved out of it.... But they shall serve the Lord their God, and David their king, whom I will raise up for them."

**Jeremiah 31:11** For the Lord has redeemed Jacob, and ransomed him from the hand of one stronger than he.



## True Peace in Jerusalem

Day 13

### Prayer Points

- That all Israelis will see that political and social solutions won't bring real and lasting peace, but only the Prince of Peace, Yeshua, can give true peace
- That Jewish and Arab believers will set an example of true unity, that is possible only in Messiah, leading to opportunities to testify of Yeshua's work and share the Good News
- For Shalom – not only absence of war, but true peace and wholeness between all the different sectors of Israeli society that are often raging against one another, so that God can fulfill His purposes for the whole nation
- That the Jewish people in Jerusalem and Israel will make peace with Yeshua and welcome Him as their Messiah, so that He will return and establish peace in all the earth

### Key Scriptures

**Psalms 122:6-8** Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: "May they prosper who love you. Peace be within your walls, prosperity within your palaces." For the sake of my brethren and companions, I will now say, "Peace be within you."

**Isaiah 19:23-25** In that day there will be a highway from Egypt to Assyria...and the Egyptians will serve with the Assyrians.

In that day Israel will be one of three with Egypt and Assyria – a blessing in the midst of the land, whom the Lord of hosts shall bless, saying, "Blessed is Egypt My people, and Assyria the work of My hands, and Israel My inheritance."

**Isaiah 26:1-4** In that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah: "We have a strong city; God will appoint salvation for walls and bulwarks. Open the gates, that the righteous nation which keeps the truth may enter in. You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You. Trust in the Lord forever, for in Yah, the Lord, is everlasting strength."

**Isaiah 60:14, 17b-18** "Also the sons of those who afflicted you shall come bowing to you, and all those who despised you shall fall prostrate at the soles of your feet; and they shall call you The City of the Lord, Zion of the Holy One of Israel....

"I will also make your officers peace, and your magistrates righteousness. Violence shall no longer be heard in your land, neither wasting nor destruction within your borders; but you shall call your walls Salvation, and your gates Praise."

**Jeremiah 33:6-9** "Behold, I will bring [Jerusalem] health and healing; I will heal them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth. And I will cause the captives of Judah and the captives of Israel to return, and will rebuild those places as at the first. I will cleanse them from all their iniquity by which they have sinned against Me, and I will pardon all their iniquities by which they have sinned and by which they have transgressed against Me. Then it shall be to Me a name of joy, a praise, and an honor before all nations of the earth, who shall hear all the good that I do to them; they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and all the peace that I provide for it."

**Ephesians 2:14-18** For He himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in His flesh the dividing wall of hostility by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances, that He might create in Himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace, and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility. And He came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near. For through Him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father.

**Matthew 23:37, 39** "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem.... How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing!... For I say to you, you shall see Me no more till you say, 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!'"


**2 Chronicles 7:14** "If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land."

**Zechariah 8:2b-3, 15b, 20b-22** "I am zealous for Zion with great zeal; with great fervor I am zealous for her." Thus says the Lord: "I will return to Zion, and dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. Jerusalem shall be called the City of Truth, the Mountain of the Lord of hosts, the Holy Mountain....

"I am determined to do good to Jerusalem and to the house of Judah. Do not fear....

"Peoples shall yet come, inhabitants of many cities; the inhabitants of one city shall go to another, saying, 'Let us continue to go and pray before the Lord, and seek the Lord of hosts. I myself will go also.'

"Yes, many peoples and strong nations shall come to seek the Lord of hosts in Jerusalem, and to pray before the Lord."



## Gentiles Fulfilling their Calling toward Israel

Day 14

### Prayer Points

- That believers around the world will truly have God's heart for Israel, loving them with an unconditional love as He does, and will have a right understanding from Scripture of His purposes for Israel and the Church
- That they will make the Jewish people a priority in evangelism and missions, hastening the day when all Israel will be saved and the resulting life from the dead for the world
- That they will pray earnestly and regularly for Israel's salvation
- That Gentile believers will provoke Jewish people to jealousy as they see the beautiful relationship these believers have with the God of Israel through the Jewish Messiah
- That they would connect with their Jewish brothers and sisters in Messiah, and partner together as one new man to build God's Kingdom

### Key Scriptures

*Some believe that the "fullness of the Gentiles" having to come in before Israel will be saved means a certain number of Gentiles coming into the Kingdom. But when you look at the context of Romans 9-11 it seems clear that the right understanding is that Gentiles must enter the fullness of their calling, and then all Israel will be saved.*

**Romans 11:25-27** For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in. And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written:

"The Deliverer will come out of Zion, and He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob; for this is My covenant with them, when I take away their sins."

**Romans 11:16-18** "For if the firstfruit is holy, the lump is also holy; and if the root is holy, so are the branches. And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree, do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, remember that you do not support the root, but the root supports you."

**Isaiah 57:14** Then it will be said: "Build up, build up, prepare the way, remove every stumbling block out of the way of My people."

**Isaiah 40:1-2** "Comfort, yes, comfort My people!" says your God. "Speak to the heart of Jerusalem, and cry out to her, that her warfare is ended, that her iniquity is pardoned; for she has received from the Lord's hand double for all her sins."

**Romans 1:16** For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes - to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile.

**Isaiah 49:22-24** Thus says the Lord God: "Behold, I will lift My hand in an oath to the nations, and set up My standard for the peoples; they shall bring your sons in their arms, and your daughters shall be carried on their shoulders; kings shall be your foster fathers, and their queens your nursing mothers; they shall bow down to you with their faces to the earth, and lick up the dust of your feet. Then you will know that I am the Lord, for they shall not be ashamed who wait for Me."

**Isaiah 60:10** "The sons of foreigners shall build up your walls, and their kings shall minister to you; for in My wrath I struck you, but in My favor I have had mercy on you."

**Romans 11:11-15** Again I ask: Did [the Jewish people] stumble so as to fall beyond recovery? Not at all! Rather, because of their transgression, salvation has come to the Gentiles, to provoke Israel to jealousy. But if their transgression means riches for the world, and their failure means riches for the Gentiles, how much greater riches will their fullness bring!

I am talking to you Gentiles. Inasmuch as I am the apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry in the hope that I may somehow provoke my own people to jealousy and save some of them. For if their rejection brought reconciliation to the world, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead?

**Romans 15:26-27** For it pleased those from Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for the poor among the saints who are in Jerusalem. It pleased them indeed, and they are their debtors. For if the Gentiles have been partakers of their spiritual things, their duty is also to minister to them in material things.





## The Poor and Needy in Israel

Day 15

### Prayer Points

- That God would work powerfully through all the believing ministries that are regularly providing aid to tens of thousands of Israelis - that He'd pour out His provision, grace, and wisdom upon them, and open doors for them to share the Gospel
- That God would work in all the hearts of those receiving help - the poor, the foreigner, the widow, the orphan, the Holocaust survivors, the new immigrants - so that they'd hunger for the Living Bread; that they'd be open to receiving the greatest gift of all, Yeshua
- That God would establish true social justice and righteousness in Israel, where the needy are taken care of and all oppression and discrimination cease
- That God will stir even more Israeli believers with compassion to reach out to the lost and broken with His love, practical help, and the Good News

### Key Scriptures

**Matthew 5:14-16** "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a basket. Instead, they put it on a lampstand so it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before men so they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."

**Isaiah 29:19** The humble also shall increase their joy in the LORD, and the poor among men shall rejoice in the Holy One of Israel.

**John 6:27, 35** "Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him...." And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst."

**Ezekiel 34:16a** "I will seek the lost, bring back the scattered, bind up the broken, and strengthen the sick"

**Psalms 147:2-3** The Lord builds up Jerusalem; He gathers together the outcasts of Israel. He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

**Micah 4:6-7** "In that day," says the Lord, "I will assemble the lame, I will gather the outcast and those whom I have afflicted; I will make the lame a remnant, and the outcast a strong nation; so the Lord will reign over them in Mount Zion from now on, even forever."

**Isaiah 14:32b** The Lord has founded Zion, and the poor of His people shall take refuge in it.

**Zechariah 7:10** "And do not oppress the widow or the orphan, the stranger or the poor; and do not devise evil in your hearts against one another."

**Luke 14:12b-14** "When you give a dinner or a supper, do not ask your friends, your brothers, your relatives, nor rich neighbors, lest they also invite you back, and you be repaid. But when you give a feast, invite the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind. And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you; for you shall be repaid at the resurrection of the just."

**Isaiah 58:6-9a, 10-11** "Is this not the fast that I have chosen: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke? Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, and that you bring to your house the poor who are cast out; when you see the naked, that you cover him, and not hide yourself from your own flesh? Then your light shall break forth like the morning, your healing shall spring forth speedily, and your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard. Then you shall call, and the Lord will answer; you shall cry, and He will say, 'Here I am.'..."

"If you extend your soul to the hungry and satisfy the afflicted soul, then your light shall dawn in the darkness, and your darkness shall be as the noonday. The Lord will guide you continually, and satisfy your soul in drought, and strengthen your bones; you shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail."

**Luke 3:11** He answered and said to them, "He who has two tunics, let him give to him who has none; and he who has food, let him do likewise."

**Deuteronomy 15:7, 11** "If there is among you a poor man of your brethren, within any of the gates in your land which the Lord your God is giving you, you shall not harden your heart nor shut your hand from your poor brother.... You shall open your hand wide to your brother, to your poor and your needy, in your land."

**Luke 10:36-37** "So which of these three do you think was neighbor to him who fell among the thieves?"

And he said, "He who showed mercy on him."

Then Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise."



## The Pro-Life Movement in Israel

Day 16

### Prayer Points

- That the shedding of the innocent blood of children in the womb will cease (2 million Israelis have been killed by abortion since the birth of the modern nation)
- That more and more Israelis will realize the horrible reality of what abortion is, and that there will be true repentance for abortion so that Israel will be able to truly receive God's blessing and protection and so that her children will fulfill their destiny
- That God will raise up an army of intercessors in Israel and the nations to stand in the gap against all forces of death and contend for life in Israel
- That God will give wisdom to create more videos and resources about this issue, and use all the materials and conversations to change many hearts and minds so that they'd instead choose life
- That God will send out more passionate believers to engage others on this topic, reaching out with grace and truth, and to help save many more lives
- That as believers share the truth about abortion, reach out with practical help to mothers in difficult situations, and speak with those who have been involved in abortions, there would be opportunities to share about the healing and forgiveness found in Jesus, and many would turn to Him
- That God will stir the hearts of government leaders to establish laws that will protect human life, beginning at conception

### Key Scriptures

**Psalm 139:13-16** For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are Your works, and that my soul knows very well. My frame was not hidden from You, when I was made in secret, and skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed. And in Your book they all were written, the days fashioned for me, when as yet there were none of them.

**Jeremiah 1:5** "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart"

**Ezekiel 20:31** "For when you offer your gifts and make your sons pass through the fire, you defile yourselves with all your idols, even to this day. So shall I be inquired of by you, O house of Israel? As I live," says the Lord God, "I will not be inquired of by you."

**Jeremiah 19:4b-6a, 7b-8** "Because they have filled this place with the blood of innocents, and have built the high places of Baal to burn their sons in the fire as burnt offerings to Baal, which I did not command or decree, nor did it come into My mind - therefore, behold, days are coming, declares the Lord.... [I] will cause their people to fall by the sword before their enemies, and by the hand of those who seek their life. I will give their dead bodies for food to the birds of the air and to the beasts of the earth. I will make this city desolate and a hissing; everyone who passes by it will be astonished and hiss because of all its plagues."

**Psalms 127:3-5** Behold, children are a heritage from the Lord, the fruit of the womb is a reward. Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, so are the children of one's youth. Happy is the man who has his quiver full of them; they shall not be ashamed, but shall speak with their enemies in the gate.

**Deuteronomy 30:19** "I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live"

**Ephesians 1:7** In [Jesus] we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace

**Proverbs 24:11-12** Rescue those who are being led away to death, and those who are stumbling toward the slaughter, oh, hold them back! If you say, "Surely we did not know this," does not He who weighs the hearts consider it? He who keeps your soul, does He not know it? And will He not render to each man according to his deeds?

**Isaiah 58:1** "Cry aloud, spare not; lift up your voice like a trumpet; tell My people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins."

**Psalms 128:3-6** Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine in the very heart of your house, your children like olive plants all around your table. Behold, thus shall the man be blessed who fears the Lord.

The Lord bless you out of Zion, and may you see the good of Jerusalem all the days of your life. Yes, may you see your children's children. Peace be upon Israel!

**Matthew 18:1-2, 10** At that time the disciples came to Jesus, saying, "Who then is greatest in the kingdom of heaven?" Then Jesus called a little child to Him, set him in the midst of them.... "Take heed that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that in heaven their angels always see the face of My Father who is in heaven."



# Religious Freedom for Believers and Wisdom for Government

Day 17

## Prayer Points

- That God will allow believers to share the Gospel in Israel without legal or political obstacles, even though ultra-Orthodox political parties are seeking to make all evangelism illegal and punishable with prison
- That in spite of occasional persecution and legal discrimination, God will grant miraculous breakthroughs, provision, protection, and freedom for believers so they can build His Kingdom in Israel
- That the political leaders of Israel will recognize their own inadequacy, repent of pride, and seek wisdom and help from God, and turn to their Messiah, Yeshua, the Wonderful Counselor
- That believers will be in places of influence to speak biblically and prophetically to the decision-makers of the nation
- That the leadership of the nation will establish true social justice for all of the sectors of society
- That economic systems will be set up that promote the flourishing of the nation, and that any corruption will be exposed and removed

## Key Scriptures

**1 Timothy 2:1-4** Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

**Isaiah 32:15a, 16-18** Until the Spirit is poured upon us from on high.... Then justice will dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness remain in the fruitful field. The work of righteousness will be peace, and the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever. My people will dwell in a peaceful habitation, in secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places.

**Isaiah 1:25-27** "Then I will turn My hand on you, purge away your dross, and remove all your alloy. I will restore your judges as at first, your counselors as at the start. Afterward you will be called City of Righteousness, Faithful City. Zion will be redeemed with justice, her repentant with righteousness."

**Isaiah 33:21-22, 24** But there the majestic One, the Lord, will be for us a place of rivers and wide canals on which no boat with oars will go, and on which no mighty ship will pass - for the Lord is our judge, the Lord is our lawgiver, the Lord is our king; He will save us - no one living in Zion will say, "I am ill"; and the sins of those who dwell there will be forgiven.

**James 1:5, 3:17** If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.... The wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

**Jeremiah 30:21** "Their nobles shall be from among them, and their governor shall come from their midst; then I will cause him to draw near, and he shall approach Me; for who is this who pledged his heart to approach Me?" says the Lord.

**Luke 21:12-19** "But before all these things, they will lay their hands on you and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons. You will be brought before kings and rulers for My name's sake. But it will turn out for you as an occasion for testimony. Therefore settle it in your hearts not to meditate beforehand on what you will answer; for I will give you a mouth and wisdom which all your adversaries will not be able to contradict or resist. You will be betrayed even by parents and brothers, relatives and friends; and they will put some of you to death. And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. But not a hair of your head shall be lost. By your patience possess your souls.

**Daniel 2:20b-22** "Blessed be the name of God forever and ever, for wisdom and might are His. And He changes the times and the seasons; He removes kings and raises up kings; He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding. He reveals deep and secret things; He knows what is in the darkness, and light dwells with Him."

**Acts 14:22** Strengthening the souls of the disciples, exhorting them to continue in the faith, and saying, "We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God."

**Isaiah 61:8** "For I, the Lord, love justice; I hate robbery for burnt offering; I will direct their work in truth, and will make with them an everlasting covenant."





## Return of Jews to their Land Israel and Restoration to their God

Day 18

### Prayer Points

- That God will help Jewish people around the world to respond to His call from the Scriptures for them to come home to the land of their fathers, Israel, and that He will fulfill His promises to restore them to Himself once they are in the Land
- That God would stir Gentile believers to fulfill their Biblical calling to help Jewish people make Aliyah (immigrate to their homeland in Israel)
- That God will use world events to bring as many Jewish people as possible to Israel, that He'd make a way for them to come, and that they'll meet their Messiah and Savior in Israel
- That Jews in the Diaspora won't be disconnected from Israel, but will instead see it as their home, and have the vision and courage to come and be a part of the miracle of Israel in spite of all the problems and challenges involved
- That the legal door will be fully opened for the nearly one million Jewish believers in Yeshua worldwide to make Aliyah and have an impact in Israel (currently it is either very difficult or even legally impossible for many to come)

### Key Scriptures

**Jeremiah 32:37-41** "Behold, I will gather them out of all countries where I have driven them in My anger, in My fury, and in great wrath; I will bring them back to this place, and I will cause them to dwell safely. They shall be My people, and I will be their God; then I will give them one heart and one way, that they may fear Me always, for their own good and for the good of their children after them. And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from doing them good; but I will put My fear in their hearts so that they will not depart from Me. Yes, I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will assuredly plant them in this land, with all My heart and with all My soul."

**Jeremiah 24:6-7** "For I will set My eyes on them for good, and I will bring them back to this land; I will build them and not pull them down, and I will plant them and not pluck them up. Then I will give them a heart to know Me, that I am the Lord; and they shall be My people, and I will be their God, for they shall return to Me with their whole heart."

**Zechariah 8:7-8** Thus says the Lord of hosts: "Behold, I will save My people from the land of the east and from the land of the west; I will bring them back, and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. They shall be My people and I will be their God, in truth and righteousness."

**Isaiah 14:1-2a** The Lord will have compassion on Jacob; once again He will choose Israel and will settle them in their own land. Foreigners will join them and unite with the descendants of Jacob. Nations will take them and bring them to their own place.

**Isaiah 11:11a, 12; 12:1-3** It shall come to pass in that day that the Lord shall set His hand again the second time to recover the remnant of His people.... He will set up a banner for the nations, and will assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

And in that day you will say: "O Lord, I will praise You; though You were angry with me, Your anger is turned away, and You comfort me. Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; 'for Yah, the Lord, is my strength and song; He also has become my salvation.' " Therefore with joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

**Jeremiah 31:8, 12a, 13b-14** "Behold, I will bring them from the north country, and gather them from the ends of the earth, among them the blind and the lame, the woman with child and the one who labors with child, together; a great throng shall return there....

"Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of Zion, streaming to the goodness of the Lord...their souls shall be like a well-watered garden...for I will turn their mourning to joy, will comfort them, and make them rejoice rather than sorrow. I will satiate the soul of the priests with abundance, and My people shall be satisfied with My goodness, says the Lord."

**Hosea 3:4-5** For the children of Israel shall abide many days without king or prince, without sacrifice or sacred pillar, without ephod or teraphim. Afterward the children of Israel shall return and seek the Lord their God and David their king. They shall fear the Lord and His goodness in the latter days.

**Ezekiel 11:17-20** "Therefore say, 'Thus says the Lord God: "I will gather you from the peoples, assemble you from the countries where you have been scattered, and I will give you the land of Israel." ' And they will go there, and they will take away all its detestable things and all its abominations from there. Then I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within them, and take the stony heart out of their flesh, and give them a heart of flesh, that they may walk in My statutes and keep My judgments and do them; and they shall be My people, and I will be their God."



## Laborers in the Harvest in Israel

Day 19

### Prayer Points

- That God would stir up the whole Body of Messiah in Israel to engage in the harvest according to the gifting and calling He's given each person, and that they would be fully equipped for the work
- For anointing, boldness, and love for all current and future laborers in the harvest in Israel, and that they would proclaim the Gospel not only in word but also in the demonstration of the power of the Spirit
- That the Lord will stir believers to help send out more full-time laborers into the harvest
- For supernatural protection for the laborers and their families from every physical, emotional, or spiritual attack
- That God will bring the Body of Messiah in Israel into greater unity, so that they can effectively partner together to build His Kingdom
- That God will use all the seeds of the Gospel sown to bring about glorious fruit of salvation and new life for Israel

### Key Scriptures

**Matthew 9:35-38** Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the Gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."

**Isaiah 35:3-6** Strengthen the weak hands, and make firm the feeble knees. Say to those who are fearful-hearted, "Be strong, do not fear! Behold, your God will come with vengeance, with the recompense of God; He will come and save you."

Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. Then the lame shall leap like a deer, and the tongue of the dumb sing. For waters shall burst forth in the wilderness, and streams in the desert.

**Jeremiah 20:9** Then I said, "I will not make mention of Him, nor speak anymore in His name." But His word was in my heart like a burning fire shut up in my bones; I was weary of holding it back, and I could not.

**Micah 3:8** But truly I am full of power by the Spirit of the Lord, and of justice and might, to declare to Jacob his transgression and to Israel his sin.

**Isaiah 52:6-7** "Therefore My people shall know My name; therefore they shall know in that day that I am He who speaks: 'Behold, it is I.'" How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who proclaims peace, who brings glad tidings of good things, who proclaims salvation, who says to Zion, "Your God reigns!"

**Isaiah 6:3-8** And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory!"

And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke.

So I said: "Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts."

Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal which he had taken with the tongs from the altar. And he touched my mouth with it, and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your iniquity is taken away, and your sin purged."

Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I! Send me."

**3 John 1:6b-7a, 8** You will do well to send them on their journey in a manner worthy of God. For they have gone out for the sake of the Name.... Therefore we ought to support people like these, that we may be fellow workers for the truth.

**Romans 10:13-15a** For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved." How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach unless they are sent?

**Luke 10:19** "I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you."



# Israel's Salvation to Bring Life from the Dead for the World

Day 20

## Prayer Points

- That God will raise up a movement of believers in Israel, filled with His Spirit and power, to bring the Gospel out of Zion just as the first Israeli disciples did
- That believers from Israel and around the world will partner together to bring the Gospel of the Kingdom to every tribe, tongue, and nation, including unreached people groups, leading to the return of Jesus
- That Yeshua will reveal Himself to Orthodox Jews who will become like the Apostle Paul and to secular Jews who will become like the Apostles Peter and John, laboring with an unwavering passion to bring the Gospel of Messiah to the ends of the earth
- That Israel as a nation would follow Yeshua and walk in His ways, giving Him glory and honor and being a testimony to the nations

## Key Scriptures

**Romans 11:11-15** Again I ask: Did [the Jewish people] stumble so as to fall beyond recovery? Not at all! Rather, because of their transgression, salvation has come to the Gentiles, to provoke Israel to jealousy. But if their transgression means riches for the world, and their failure means riches for the Gentiles, how much greater riches will their fullness bring!

I am talking to you Gentiles. Inasmuch as I am the apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry in the hope that I may somehow provoke my own people to jealousy and save some of them. For if their rejection brought reconciliation to the world, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead?

**Isaiah 60:1-3** Arise, shine; for your light has come! And the glory of the Lord is risen upon you. For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and deep darkness the people; but the Lord will arise over you, and His glory will be seen upon you. The Gentiles shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising.

**Isaiah 2:2-3, 5** Now it shall come to pass in the latter days that the mountain of the Lord's house shall be established on the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow to it. Many people shall come and say, "Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob; He will teach us His ways, and we shall walk in His paths." For out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.... O house of Jacob, come and let us walk in the light of the Lord.

**Isaiah 43:21** [Of Israel]: This people I have formed for Myself; they shall declare My praise.

**Isaiah 52:9-10** Break forth into joy, sing together, you waste places of Jerusalem! For the Lord has comforted His people, He has redeemed Jerusalem. The Lord has made bare His holy arm in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God.

**Matthew 24:14** And this Gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.

**Isaiah 61:9-11** "Their descendants shall be known among the Gentiles, and their offspring among the people. All who see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the posterity whom the Lord has blessed."

I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels. For as the earth brings forth its bud, as the garden causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth, so the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations.

**Ezekiel 20:40-41** "For on My holy mountain, on the high mountain of Israel," declares the Lord God, "there the entire house of Israel, all of them, will serve Me in the land; there I will accept them and there I will demand your contributions and the choicest of your gifts, with all your holy things. As a soothing aroma I will accept you when I bring you out from the peoples and gather you from the lands where you are scattered; and I will show Myself to be holy among you in the sight of the nations."

**Zechariah 8:23** "Thus says the Lord of hosts: 'In those days ten men from every language of the nations shall grasp the sleeve of a Jewish man, saying, "Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you." ' ' "

**Psalms 102:13-16** You will arise and have mercy on Zion; for the time to favor her, yes, the set time, has come. For Your servants take pleasure in her stones, and show favor to her dust. So the nations shall fear the name of the Lord, and all the kings of the earth Your glory. For the Lord shall build up Zion; He shall appear in His glory.





# A Movement of Watchmen on the Walls of Jerusalem

Day 21

## Prayer Points

- That God will help believers around the world recognize the beauty of His plan for Israel and the Church, and that they will passionately take part in interceding for God's purposes
- That God will raise up over 100 million intercessors who will never keep silent and give God no rest until Israel's salvation shines as a burning torch and His purposes are complete for Israel and the nations
- That those praying for Israel will receive the blessings God has promised in their own lives as they bless Israel through their prayers

## Key Scriptures

**Isaiah 52:8** Your watchmen shall lift up their voices, with their voices they shall sing together; for they shall see eye to eye when the Lord brings back Zion.

**Isaiah 62:1-12** For Zion's sake I will not keep silent, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not be quiet, until her righteousness goes forth as brightness, and her salvation as a burning torch. The nations shall see your righteousness, and all the kings your glory, and you shall be called by a new name that the mouth of the Lord will give. You shall be a crown of beauty in the hand of the Lord, and a royal diadem in the hand of your God. You shall no more be termed Forsaken, and your land shall no more be termed Desolate, but you shall be called My Delight Is in Her, and your land Married; for the Lord delights in you, and your land shall be married. For as a young man marries a young woman, so shall your sons marry you, and as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so shall your God rejoice over you.

On your walls, O Jerusalem, I have appointed watchmen; all day and all night they will never keep silent. You who make mention of the Lord, take no rest for yourselves; and give Him no rest until He establishes and until He makes Jerusalem a praise in the earth.

The Lord has sworn by his right hand and by his mighty arm: "I will not again give your grain to be food for your enemies, and foreigners shall not drink your wine for which you have labored; but those who garner it shall eat it and praise the Lord, and those who gather it shall drink it in the courts of my sanctuary."

Go through, go through the gates; prepare the way for the people; build up, build up the highway; clear it of stones; lift up a signal over the peoples.

Behold, the Lord has proclaimed to the end of the earth: Say to the daughter of Zion, "Behold, your salvation comes; behold, His reward is with Him, and His recompense before Him." And they shall be called The Holy People, the Redeemed of the Lord; and you shall be called Sought Out, A City Not Forsaken.

**Jeremiah 31:7, 10** For thus says the Lord: "Sing with gladness for Jacob, and shout among the chief of the nations; proclaim, give praise, and say, 'O Lord, save Your people, the remnant of Israel!..."

"Hear the word of the Lord, O nations, and declare it in the isles afar off, and say, 'He who scattered Israel will gather him, and keep him as a shepherd does his flock.' "

*In the context of Israel's restoration, God promised that when the prayer and worship movement that David launched is fully restored, the result will be a harvest so massive that the laborers won't be able to gather it in quickly enough:*

**Amos 9:11-13** "On that day I will raise up the tabernacle of David, which has fallen down, and repair its damages; I will raise up its ruins, and rebuild it as in the days of old; that they may possess the remnant of Edom, and all the Gentiles who are called by My name," says the Lord who does this thing.


"Behold, the days are coming," says the Lord, "when the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him who sows seed; the mountains shall drip with sweet wine, and all the hills shall flow with it."

**Numbers 6:23b-27** "This is the way you shall bless the children of Israel. Say to them: 'The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make His face shine upon you, and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace.' So they shall put My name on the children of Israel, and I will bless them."

**Genesis 12:3** "I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

**Psalms 20:1-5** May the Lord answer you in the day of trouble; may the name of the God of Jacob defend you; may He send you help from the sanctuary, and strengthen you out of Zion; may He remember all your offerings, and accept your burnt sacrifice. Selah

May He grant you according to your heart's desire, and fulfill all your purpose. We will rejoice in your salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners! May the Lord fulfill all your petitions.



For nearly 2,000 years, lies and misconceptions have deeply affected Jewish people's view of Jesus, Yeshua. The result is that the vast majority of them think He can't possibly be the Messiah.
